Diamond Accreditation Program

Valley VNA's assisted living is a member of the Wisconsin Assisted Living Association (WALA). One of our 2014 initiatives is to participate in the WALA Diamond Accreditation program.

This program is designed to help assisted living facilities maintain and improve high standards of quality care and services where individual needs are met in a safe, healthy, respectful and dignified environment. This is accomplished through the design and development of quality management approaches and setting up and measuring quality indicators.

The goal is to work through the process and reach accreditation status after three years. Achieving accredited status means Valley VNA has voluntarily undergone a formal evaluation process by WALA and been awarded official recognition for meeting or exceeding specific quality standards.

Valley VNA's Helpline - If you're like many people, the end of the day may be when you find time to do online research. In response to that we have launched a new community resource called "Helpline". This is a confidential, online-based service that

is free and available to the public. Through this Helpline, Valley VNA can assist seniors and their families who have questions about senior services and resources in the Fox Cities area.

Wellness Coordinator! We're

pleased to have a new partner - Brent Jacobs, RehabCare's Wellness Coordinator. Brent will be working with our residents and employees to improve their health and wellness. His plan includes services such as resident Walking Clubs, Wheelchair and Walker Tune-Up Clinics, free Senior Fitness and Health Assessments and Health Learning lectures. Brent will help design fitness plans for any interested resident and will be working with staff to individualize activities for those who are not independent in ambulation.

GERi ™ nursing skills manikin is a full size functional training manikin that will be used for hands on training for caregiving staff in both assisted living and in home care. GERi ™ has a superior range of motion and can simulate up to 35 different nursing procedures. This will be beneficial in providing a teaching tool not only for proper skills but also to give confidence to new and existing caregivers.


Caring for the Caregiver
